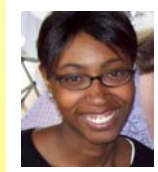


## PEER MINISTRY PROGRAM

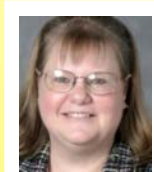

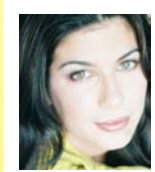

## WORSHIP AT CNR

**LITURGY** The principal Sunday liturgy is celebrated at 11:00 a.m. in Holy Family Chapel on the New Rochelle campus. A weekday liturgy is celebrated in the side Chapel when classes are in session. Mass begins at 8:45 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday, and at 12:30 p.m. on Wednesday. We invite you to join our celebrations and to consider becoming a *Eucharistic Minister, Lector, Chapel Choir Member, or Minister of Hospitality*. Prayers for special needs at either our Sunday or weekday liturgies can be requested.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** may be arranged with the Chaplain, as well as arrangements for Catholic marriages for Alumnae/i of CNR.

**Ecumenical and interfaith services** are available on campus. We invite those of all faiths to join us in the planning and implementation of these services.

**The Lord's Pantry** – deliver meals to the homebound

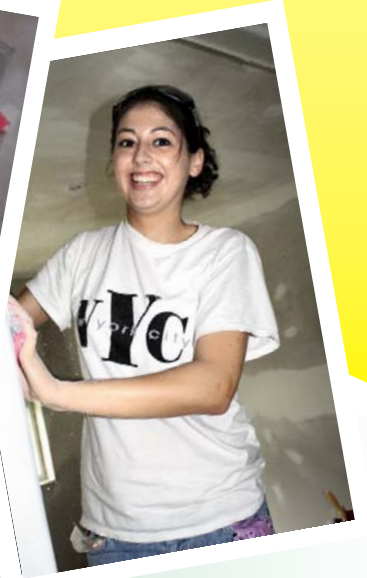
